 All subjects are interrelated and topics are introduced as greater parts of the whole.






ROLE OF THE GUIDE AND THE ADOLESCENT

MONTESSORI TA (TEACHER ADVISORY) COMMUNITIES



Gunston middle school has 30-minutes of TA built into th schedule each day. Montessori TA's have all three grade levels combined.


ENGLISH BLOCK





- provides additional support for students during and after school.




